- Participate on Clinical Supervisors' Team, Leadership Council, and other agency Panels as requested.

- Conduct and provide billable services to meet minimum established productivity expectations. May provide diagnostic assessments and/or billable services as needed.
- Other duties as assigned.

Skills and Experience

- Supervisory and organizational skills; written and verbal communication skills.
