#### Responsibilities

The Mental Health Prevention Specialist provides supportive interventions, consultation, and AoD prevention groups for children and/or adolescents and possibly families in participating service programs throughout Stark County. The Prevention Specialist has the responsibility of maintaining uniformly high-quality service to ensure maximum benefits to program participants. The individual must have strong communication skills with both children, adolescents, and adults, enjoy helping others, be organized, energetic, innovative and enthusiastic, maintain a family-oriented

- Maintain accurate records of service delivery and timely completion of paperwork.
- Promote a climate that fosters resiliency and positive social, emotional, and behavioral development.
- Attend collaborative team meetings to create positive change within the community.
- Attend continuing education opportunities to obtain and/or maintain the Ohio Certified Prevention Specialist Licensure and/or CDCA licensure.

- Provide coordination and referral to community services, as needed.
- Act as an advocate for children and/or adolescents and their families, and childcare providers.
